


DIGITAL LIBRARY OF LATVIA: SHARING CULTURAL HERITAGE AND DRIVING DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION

WHO WE ARE





THE DIGITAL LIBRARY SOLUTION




At the core of the Digital Cultural Heritage platform, the Digital Library facilitates the **unified dissemination** of digital cultural heritage objects. The Digital Object Management System ensures the **unified management and preservation** of digital cultural heritage objects, including the maintenance of a standardized and consolidated catalog of digital cultural heritage objects. The Reference Data Solution has been implemented to manage **unified description and structuring of cultural heritage values.** It provides accessibility to a shared cultural heritage reference data pool, ensuring consistency and coherence. To navigate the complexities of **copyrights and access rights**, the Digital Cultural Heritage Platform incorporates a sophisticated copyright management and licensing system.

Reference data entities include various attributes such as name, place, institution, etc. Reference data entities are interconnected, which helps the user find digital objects or information. All partner institutions data have been linked together so that nothing is lost.
